



**Want your kids to know more about faith traditions other their own?**  
*Reimagining Interfaith* will include a **Kids' Track!**



It's never too early to share the world's faith traditions with your kids. The Kids' Track will provide a wonderful opportunity for your children to explore the world's major faith traditions using tried-and-true, age-appropriate methods. We'll start each day with an ice-breaker and an opening ritual. We'll end each day with a closing ritual. In between, we will:

- Read stories
- Sing songs
- Make crafts
- Learn about holy days
- Eat traditional foods
- Explore common ritual practices

The Kids' Track will be offered concurrently with adult sessions, and Kids' Track participants will have the same breaks/meal-times as their caregivers.

We'll primarily focus on religious traditions with the largest number of adherents across the globe but that are minorities in North America: Judaism, Buddhism, Hinduism/Vedanta, and Islam. Additional topics will be included depending on the faith practices of our participants. There are amazing narratives, fun crafts, and interesting holidays in ALL religious traditions, and kids will certainly have opportunities to share their own perspectives. Comparisons to Christian symbols, rituals, and holidays will also be included where appropriate.

We'll wrap up the program with some "faith-in-action" brainstorming and activities that revolve around the Golden Rule, creation care, and age-appropriate social justice initiatives.
